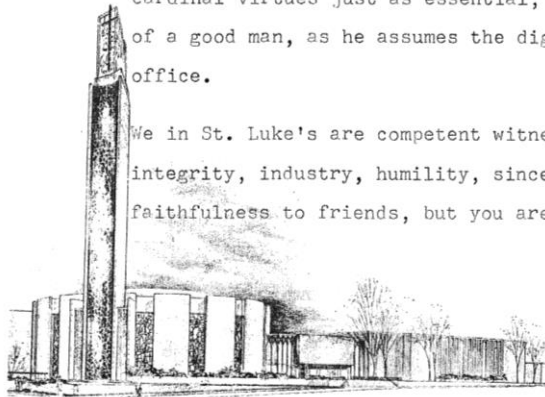
To the Honorable Judge William J. Holloway -

Our country and the affairs of State are in good hands with men like you sitting in legal judgment and we who really know you thank God and Country for you.

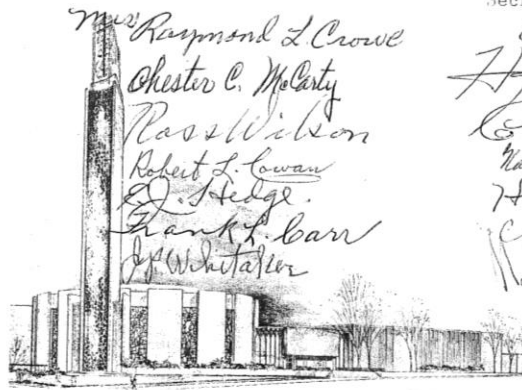
